

The Bowling Green Township Comprehensive Plan Committee met Wednesday June 16, 2010 at 5:30PM in the Township Community Building.

Committee Chairperson Michael Pitcher called the meeting to order at 5:30PM.

Committee reviewed the community survey results provided by LCPC. A total of 168 responses were recorded. While tabulated results were available, the comments (typed in by Dee Krier) were not displayed on the reports. LCPC to work on getting the comments printed with the survey results.

Although the comments will be required for prioritizing the Comp Plan issues, it is apparent that the majority of respondents would like a township newsletter. Committee will present this finding at the next Trustee meeting.

Other areas of interest were farmland preservation, historical site preservation, and the development of full on/off ramps at I-70 at Brownsville. Pitcher will coordinate with Trustees on how Soil & Water might present to the community regarding farmland preservation and grant funding (perhaps at the next community picnic).

Next meeting will be focused on defining, listing, and prioritizing the important issues to address in the Comprehensive Plan.
